

Fees & Funding:

We can claim **1140** hours per year for **30 hours** per week funding, and we offer this over a full year basis, spread across 52 weeks per year.

On a monthly average, this works out to be 95 hours per month funded. Our private rate is £92 per session. This provides family with a discount of £874 per month off their private fees. (95 hours x £9.20)

For children who only attend 2 sessions per week, we can only claim 86.6 hours per month (20 a week).

We can claim **570** hours per year for **15 hours** per week funding, and we offer this over a full year basis, spread across 52 weeks per year.

On a monthly average, this works out to be 47.5 hours per month funded. Our private rate is £92 per session. This provides family with a discount of £437 per month off their private fees. (47.5 hours x £9.20)

Consumables charge:

We charge £1.80 per hour for the funded hours (95 hours per month funded), monthly total is £171. For children who attend 2 sessions only, they are charged less because we are not making a full claim for funding (86.6 hours per month only = £156). For children using 15 hours funding, the flat rate for consumables is £85.50 per month.

What does this cover?

Funded hours only cover care and do not cover the things that are consumed or used by the children during their time with us. This also covers things like trips, annual parties and experiences the children access during their time with us (this does not cover extra curriculum classes). Whilst older children do not use nappies, they have more opportunities for trips and community experiences than the younger children, so we have balanced this out across the board.

- Breakfast (toast, cereal, fresh fruit platter, yogurt)
 - Hot lunch & cheese of the day
 - Fresh fruit snack
 - Afternoon tea
 - Nappies, wipes & creams (including sun cream)
 - Toilet paper, hand wash, first aid materials etc.
 - Milk and milk alternative's
 - Arts & crafts materials
 - Messy play materials and food for real life play experience
- Trips, we cover travel costs for staff and will pay for any paid trips too (lunches for trips will be included if hours cross over lunch time)
 - Graduation leavers trip and party is fully paid for by us
 - Dry cleaning of blankets for children who sleep
