What it is, how it looks and when you see it

In line with our theme there is an adult led planned activity which all children engage in and this is recorded for observation in their learning journey. This is of course along side many activities that are offered every day of the week and teachers are constantly making every day observations of children's milestones and next steps.

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NEXT STEPS

How they are completed, when you are notified

Next steps and child interest boards are in each room. Key workers work on next steps with the children. Next steps are logged on Ovivio as golden moments and then once achieved extra details are provided.

DAILY ACTIVITIES

Daily activities take place covering the 7 areas of development: Physical, Communication and language, Personal, social and emotional, Mathematics, Literacy, Expressive art and design and Understanding the world. We actively encourage children to learn through 3 main ways, playing and exploring, active learning and critical thinking.

Daily activities are a blend of child interest activities, curriculum based activities and activities which benefit children's next steps.
